The AS/NZS 4360 Risk Management Standard has been adopted by the National Health Service in the UK, Canada, Korea and several other countries.

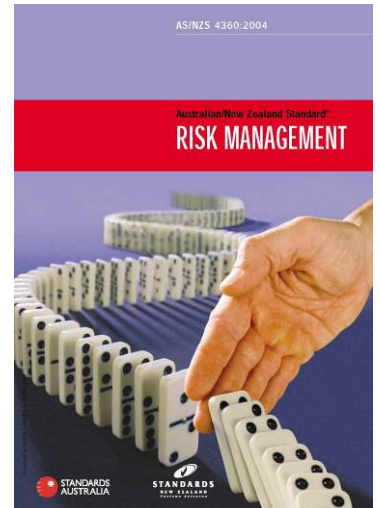
The workshop outlines the main concepts of risk management and also draws the link between the risk management process and the role of leadership and management systems, and will include the following topics:
